Types of internships:

Italian regulations allow two types of internships:

	Curricular internship	Extracurricular internship
Target	Students	Recent graduates
Period	Before graduation, while attending a university course	After graduation (the University of Milan has the role of promoter for students who got their degree within 12 months)
Regulation	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- national law- regional law- university/faculty regulations	Regional regulations are applied; the University of Milan activates extracurricular internships in Lombardy
Compensation	It is not compulsory. Each host institution can decide whether giving it or not	Compulsory by law

Traineeships and internships

An internship (or traineeship) is an opportunity for students and graduates to put into practice what they have learnt during their studies, and approach the job market.

Our University sets up two types of internships:

- **curricular internships**, for **students** enrolled in a study programme of the University of Milan (Bachelor's, Master's, vocational master, etc.);
- **extracurricular internships**, for **recent graduates** (those who completed a study programme no more than 12 months earlier).

Curricular internships allow for the **acquisition of credits** in accordance with the modalities set out for each study programme, and must be completed before graduation.


You can find curricular and extracurricular internship opportunities on your own, or through the channels made available by the University (**Jobs and Internships noticeboard**).

Once you have found a suitable internship opportunity, you and your host institution (company, public entity, freelance professional, etc.) have to complete the internship set-up process before you can start your curricular or extracurricular internship, as explained below:

- For internships carried out at **host institutions located in Italy**, the host institution will first be required to sign an **internship agreement** with the University (those that have already signed this document can skip this step). All the details are available in the section **Internship agreement**. Once the internship agreement is in force, please **carefully follow the instructions** available at **Activating a curricular internship** or **Extracurricular internships**, depending on the type of internship you are going to carry out.
- For internships carried out at **host institutions located abroad**, please follow the instructions available at **Activating an internship abroad**.
